Dear Rae,

"eceived you letter with a delay of almost a day. Hope this will reach you before Monday as I want to give you some of our ideas on the "trial".

But first as to the money. You are swell, and I shall acknowledge the receipts separately to the contributors a day or two later. Becker pledged two dollars monthly and has given me the first two already (at the beginning of September) but I would very much like to apply that to August and, if at all possible inveigle him somehow to contribute again for September Do you think we might succeed in view of the "emergency" now existing? And as a matter of fact, Rae dear, the situation was never so black as now. I will give you a few extracts from a letter by com.Held (of course, very confidential). EIGHT police are guarding ID day and night. All mail is censured, no phone calls, or cables. Incoming mail is censured as well. He lives under the conditions of a "glorified" concentration camp; Money is needed, loads of it to institute suitage not the Norwegian government, censured, no phone calls, or cables. This will also put the treacherous Norwegian Labor Party "on the spot". These people have the check to say that L.D. broke "the pledge" he gave not to interefere into the internal affairs of Norway. They cite his writings in the international press and visitors. They knew about his writings all along and never breathed a word in protest (as a matter of act they reprintedmany of them), they knew about the visitors—why L.D. gave Isaacs, for instance, a b tter of introduction to several editors without whom Isaacs gave an interview on China. They knew about it (the interview of peared also in the labor press) and never breathed a word against it. Now, that they are giving in to the demand of the Norwe—gian fascists (and Stellinist bonapartists) for muzzling the "old man" they drag in the accusation of a "broken pledge". All this must be exposed. An effective guard has to be built up around L.D. — his life was never so immediately in danger as now — as you probably understand. An effort must be made to get larger donations. Here in New York so far a couple of commades gave very heavy contributions but no campgaign has been developed whatso—ever, it is true that no public mangai campaign could be made but still....

Isaacs gave more than five hund red dollars, the Konnikows, including Wright about four hund red.. (Not a word from Glantz — I expect to pay him a special visit, no matter how unpleasant it may be).

Now to the trial itself. Fossibly what I will state here, you will have thought about yourself and it will be a fare repetition. But I believe it is worth it. Light on it can be shed from various angles. First, that the whole frame up was planned as far back as the fireff assassination, this is borne out by the fact that Litvinoff signed spact with capitalist gover ments against terrorists (in connection with the assassination of Alexander and Barthou), by so doing he laid a base for asking for the extradition of political exponents (now under guise of "terrorists"). No evidence of a plot to will could be foisted upon Zinoviev and Kameneff who were merely kept in Jail as "corrupters of youth", and at the time of the Kiroff business, how then did it happen that people who sat in Jail could have plotted all that that they later "confessed" they did? No doubt, that members of the GFU, Olberg, David abd Lurle, were planted among them, it is more than likelyothat they too have been killed (although that cannot be proven with cartainty) to do away with those who knew too much how the whole fiffair was being prepared (just as in the melchatag fire trial affair, all the Nazis, (except one, who escaped - who participated in that I to on the side of the government, were done away with so as to close their mouths forever. forever.

Entx Why this haste in executions? Why no representative of the Second International was allowed to sit in?

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But what is the FOLITICAL meaning of the trial? The obvious answer is, to cover up the betrayal in Spain and France. Yes, partly it is so. As a matter of fact, the tremendous demonstration in Moscow on behalf of Spain frightened the bureaucrats sick. The masses for the first time in many many years went out into the streets with a genuine enthusiasms and among the wany banners carried, to be sure, there were some whodemanded help to Spain, etc.

But even more important that this is the new turn of Moscow as reflected now in France. And that is the call for a FRENCH FRONT (no longer Fogular Front). You see the Popular Front is not all-inclusive enough. Smax&Fakure The French CP through the mouths of Thorax and Duclos advocates unity of all Frenchmen fax for the defense of the laws, for national economy, for the liberty and independence of France (quoted verbatim from Thorax report on August 7th) As a mitter of fact thankxiaxania we have good reason to believe that negotiations with French generals, like Petain, are going on for the "French Front". The CP of France feels that it cannot rely on a weak-kneed support of a popular front Government with Elum, it needs the big bourgeoisie, with its generals. For what? For a war with Germany. They will make agreement with anybody, as long as they will be on the side of the USSR as against Germany. This is the stage the frenco-Russian alliance reached now. What is the price the generals demaind? We can only surmise. May be it was already paid .... by the execution of the leading figures who at one time or another were close to Lenin. This is the final guarantee Russia is giving that it has nothing to do with old Bolshevism.

As a matter of fact, the CP of France is quietly proceeding to blow up the whols Popular Front. "Quietly", I say, because it is afraid of its own followers. The refusal of allowing the representative of the Se and International to be present at the trial is an indication of the break with the Fopular Front forces, the request for help to Spain which brings pressure on Bluma nd jeopardizes the Popular Front is an indication of that. Although, of course, it has even more significance. And this is that the Soviet bureaucrats became convinced that they cannot escape wer in the near future, and if so, they will better choose the moment. And they choose it now. But they refer to see France envolved first, that is the real meaning of the agitation for help to Spain. They ask for help to Spain not to bush Spain on the road of proletarian revolution, and certainly not to help French workers take that road, but simply and purely to involve France in an imperialist war against Germany with Russia on the side of Rrance. As a matter of fact, huseia hopes by this means to tie the French workers hand and foot and also muzzle its dwn stirring masses more effectively.

That is enough on my part. L.D.'s article did notarrive, we have farrexts reason to believe that it wasconfiscated. You saw his little note on Olberg and how this GFU spy traix tried to penetrate the LD household in the guise of secretary to ID. - thank the stars this did not work. LD's article on Spain has been printed in the Socialist Appeal? have you got it? The gist of this that the whole army has to be bebuilt from top to bottom, the officers corps destroyed, obly then can the army be surged of fascists and carry on an effective fight against the fascists.
